VIRGINIA LÓPEZ VALIENTE CEO Cruises News Media Group

THOMAS SPINA President Busability

Mr. Spina joined the Busability team as President in March of 2020. He previously served as Senior Vice President of Bahamas Paradise Cruise Line overseeing Commerical Operations for the private cruise company. Oversight included Shipboard Human Resources, Marine/Technical, Onboard Revenue, Terminal Operations, Casino, and Entertainment. He also worked as Director of Business Development for the Global Ports and Destination Development Group for Carnival Corporation which included oversight as the Port Director for the Grand Turk Cruise Center which saw over 1 million passengers per year. Prior to his time at Carnival Corporation, Mr. Spina joined Norwegian Cruise Line and Norwegian Cruise Line Holdings first as Director of Port Finance and Analysis and then overseeing global port operations as Vice President, Port Operations for NCLH's three brands, Norwegian Cruise Line, Oceania Cruises, and Regent Seven Seas. Previously to joining NCLH in Miami, Mr. Spina worked for the New York City Economic Development Corporation (NYCEDC) as the Vice President of Cruise Ship Operations during Mayor Michael Bloomberg's Administration. During his time there, Spina oversaw a massive \$250 Million port renovation plan which spurred cruise ship growth in the harbor, expanded economic impact through brand diversity, and attracted year round cruising from New York City. Prior to his time at NYCEDC, he was with the State University of New York - Maritime College serving afloat as the Executive Officer of the Training Ship EMPIRE STATE and ashore as a senior level officer to the Commandant of Cadets.

During his nearly 30 – year career in the maritime industry, Mr. Spina served as an active duty U.S. Coast Guard Officer and a Senior Marine Surveyor for National Cargo Bureau, Inc. Mr. Spina provided insight and direction to some of the world's largest cargo and cruise vessels, including Hanjin, Mediterranean Shipping, and Norwegian Cruise Line. He additionally served afloat as a 3rd Mate during Hurricane Katrina relief efforts.

A frequent presenter at cruise industry events, Mr. Spina continues to be an active participant in industry affairs. He served as member of the AAPA Cruise Committee and was a Passenger Vessel Sub-Committee member in New York Harbor during his time at NYCEDC. He helped coordinate and administer many high profile events in New York Harbor including Cunard's "Three Queen's Royal Rendezvous", US Armed Forces Fleet Week, numerous cruise ship inaugurations, and the INTREPID Sea, Space and Air Museum's return to Pier 86.

Mr. Spina holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration in Marine Transportation from the State University of New York (SUNY) Maritime College and an unlimited tonnage 3rd Mates License to sail on any size vessel in the world. He is currently pursuing his Masters Degree in International Transportation Management at SUNY Maritime
